

Paul Mounds Jr. is the Vice President of Community, Corporate, and Government Relations for Yale New Haven Health, where he leads external affairs across Connecticut, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and New York, and Washington DC. He oversees government relations, corporate and community partnerships, and civic engagement for a system that includes seven hospitals, a nationally recognized children's hospital, Yale New Haven Urgent Care, and Northeast Medical Group, with over 32,000 employees and 8,200 physicians.

Paul previously served as Chief of Staff and Chief Operating Officer to Connecticut Governor Ned Lamont, managing the state's \$50 billion budget and leading the pandemic response. He has also held senior roles with Governor Dannel Malloy, Senator Richard Blumenthal, and Congressman John Larson.

He serves as Chair of the Governance Committee at Trinity College, his alma mater, and is Vice Chair of the Governor's Prevention Partnership. He formerly served on the University of Connecticut Board of Trustees and was a Visiting Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School's Taubman Center for State and Local Government.
