

Qiana Mickie is New York City's inaugural Executive Director of the NYC Mayor's Office of Urban Agriculture. Under Qiana's leadership, the office aims to advance urban agriculture and equity to actively address climate, health, and food disparities in the city's natural and built environment. By collaborating with interagency leaders as well as the breadth of urban agriculture stakeholders, Qiana has developed innovative initiatives to foster healthy, culturally relevant food production, increase ag education to students, build an M/WBE pipeline for small and socially disadvantaged businesses to city procurement, and bolster land security for community gardeners. She released NYC's first urban agriculture report and action plan in 2023.

Qiana is also the Founding Principal of QJM Multiprise and the former Executive Director of Just Food. Qiana has a B.S. in Marketing from Hampton University and received her Food Hub Management certification from the University of Vermont. She currently serves on the USDA Urban Agriculture and Innovative Production Federal Advisory Committee.
